The Wabash facility will cease normal operations on November 7, 2008 and South Boston, Virginia on November 28, 2008. The consolidation of our facilities will be seamless to our customers over the next couple of months with no interruption of supply. The order process and payment method will remain unchanged during this transition. Our facilities at Wilmington, Ohio and Newcomerstown, Ohio are not affected by this consolidation.
